Good practices

- In preparation for conducting practical examinations online amidst the COVID-19 pandemic, the junior college has formulated and disseminated guidelines for online admission selection and established a working group. In addition, the junior college follows the guidelines issued by the competent public health center, and carries out simulations ahead of examinations. These careful measures to prevent the spread of infection are worthy of evaluation.
- The junior college has established a Music and Society Course aimed at senior citizens. This initiative is worthy of evaluation in terms of both national lifelong learning promotion policies and countermeasures to future birthrate decline.
- Subsidized by the junior college and Alumni Association, the student cafeteria provides breakfast for 100 yen and dinner for 200 yen. This initiative has the effect of achieving high student satisfaction and providing economic support, food education, and nutritional management and is therefore worthy of evaluation.
- By introducing a point system, the junior college is successfully expanding library users and reducing the number of borrowed items being returned late. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
