Good practices

- With regard to initiatives addressing students' dropping out, taking a leave of absence, repeating a year of their courses through collaboration between faculty and staff, the university makes serious efforts to provide careful guidance to students through counselling and advice by means of Fourperson Interviews among the student, their parent/guardian, their seminar supervisor, and a Student affairs Department staff member. These initiatives are worthy of high evaluation.
- The university's large, well-equipped sports center not only contributes greatly to maintaining students' health and learning environment, but also plays a useful role in cooperation with the local community by broadly accepting users from outside the university. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
- The university's PDCA cycle for internal quality assurance is operating organically and effectively through measures such as the utilization of surveys and analysis conducted by the IR Center, the Self-Inspection and Evaluation Committee's promotion of concrete measures for internal quality assurance, and the incorporation of improvement and enhancement measures in the next academic year plan of the mid-term plan. These initiatives are worthy of high evaluation.
