Good practices

- O Three academic ability elements linked to the admissions policy have been stipulated, entrance selection points based on the degree of emphasis are notified in the student application guidelines, and the efforts made to secure diverse students in line with the admissions policy. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
- O A Learning Support Cram School is operated in which support is given by faculty and support teachers including graduates, students' acquisition of knowledge is encouraged, and the way the university implements initiatives to improve the enrichment level of learning and class instruction support is worthy of evaluation.
- O Recommendations are received from the Student Satisfaction Improvement Squadron that consists of students representatives and faculty, and these are linked in with improvements to learning, lifestyle and environment, etc. The fact that a system to capture student opinions has been created and effectively used is worthy of high evaluation.
- O Using a follow-up system, students who are deemed not to have acquired the satisfactory level of knowledge are made to re-study for a follow-up period, and the way the university is dealing with students according to their leaning abilities and building up students' knowledge in each school year is worthy of evaluation.
