Good practices

- As a countermeasure against students dropping out of the university it uses the n-pass learning support system to disclose and share information on students attendance with parents and guardians, and makes an effort to enable the university and parents and guardians to check students attendance in a collaborative manner. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- The enriching career support system, transcending faculties, for students wishing to become teachers through the university's education and learning program for fostering teachers (Nittai Kyogakusha) in collaboration between faculty and staff is worthy of evaluation.
- The university was one of the earliest in Japan to be approved as a COVID-19 occupational vaccination site; started vaccinations for students, faculty and staff; sought to prepare an environment in which students could spend their school life with peace of mind; and contributed to encouraging the vaccination of the local community and those planning to study overseas. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
- Using the Yukon Scholarship that is established through the donations of faculty and staff, the number of students who dropped out of the university due to unpaid education fees was smaller than usual despite the COVID-19 pandemic, and this initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- The NSSU Clinic has been opened in the Tokyo Setagaya Campus, and provides sports injury treatment, prevention and advice not only to students, faculty and staff but also the local residents. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
