

Ueno Gakuen University (上野学園大学)

Evaluation summary

During the academic year 2017 evaluation and accreditation, Point Evaluated 3-6 “Financial base and fiscal balance” was judged as being unsatisfactory, as was Standard 3. “Management, Administration and Finance.” The University is in need of fully-fledged reforms because the financial assets of the University's incorporated entity as a whole are in decline, and it is in an ongoing state of being unable to secure a stable financial base.

However, as it was judged that it would be feasible to reform the cause of the standard deemed unsatisfactory within the space of one year, it was decided to wait for the results of the re-evaluation before making a final decision and the comprehensive judgment on the University had therefore been deferred.

With regard to Point Evaluated 3-6 for Standard 3, the results of an academic year 2019 re-evaluation centering on the matters for reform pointed out in the academic year 2017 revealed that as the number of entrants continues to fall vastly below the yearly enrollment quotas the financial assets of the University's incorporated entity continue to decline, and it cannot be said that a stable financial base has been established.
