Good practices

- All students are provided with tablet computers to use in flip teaching etc., and ingenuity is shown in class content and teaching methods. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.

Recommendations for improvement

- Improvements are required as there is no stipulation in line with Article 93, paragraph (2), item (iii) of the School Education Act that “The President shall stipulate important matters regarding education and research in which the opinion of the Faculty Council is required.”
- Improvements are required as the publication of the performance of faculty members obligated under Article 172-2 of the Regulation for Enforcement of the School Education Act is not being implemented.
- Improvements are required as there are no stipulations on matters or content regarding delegation in Article 16 of the articles of endowment “delegation of business decisions.”
- There are partial inadequacies regarding the publication of information pursuant to legislation, the provision of regulations pursuant to the gist of legislation, and the provision of regulations for management of the Board of Directors conforming to the current situation. As these cannot be described as adequate from the perspective of internal quality assurance, improvements are required.
