Good practices

- Respectfully reflecting the traditions and history of Daikakuji Gakuen and its surrounding environment in its cross-university initiatives and firmly maintaining its founding principles, the university has changed its name, which is a clear message to society about the traditions, individuality and distinctive quality of “Sagabi,” as it has been popularly known in the local community. This has led to success in the recruitment of students, and these initiatives are worthy of evaluation.

- From the academic year 2018 the university launched an individually developed job hunting activity smartphone application called “SAGABiZ,” which provides timely information to students by being updated on a daily basis. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.

- The university has been declared a designated refuge area by the local Kyoto City, it implements regular joint evacuation drills with local residents’ associations and neighboring elementary schools, and has established an evacuation center that will accept evacuees in times of disasters. These initiatives represent the implementation of the Daikakuji Gakuen Code of Conduct, and are worthy of evaluation.
