Good practices

- In addition to the need to equip students with the graduate attributes in line with the three policies (diploma, curriculum and admission policies), and in order to improve students' abilities to live their lives, from the perspective of a comprehensive human education a further fourth policy, the Guidance Policy, has been added to the three policies, forming the AEGG Policies. This clarifies educational targets and is an initiative worthy of evaluation.
- Regulations on Support for Study of Students with Disabilities have been stipulated to respond to students with disabilities, a Disabled Students Support Committee has also been set up, and a cross-university support system has been prepared and is in operation. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- A satellite campus has been established in the center of Sendai City, and is used to exhibit work and research results by students, faculty and staff etc., and as a venue for workshops and research presentations. It functions effectively as a university activities base for local collaboration and presenting research results. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- Since the academic year 2016, as a mechanism to cover student absences permitted by the university and in which the student is not at fault the university has clarified its intention to offset absences by providing special instruction to students for studies they have missed. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
