Good practices

- The Peace Studies and Nagasaki Studies courses common to all faculties have been launched and the establishment of liberal arts education courses taking local characteristics into account. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
- Surveys are conducted of faculty members' degree of satisfaction regarding the research environment, and improvements in the research environment surrounding researchers (both faculty members and graduate school students) are sought. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.

Recommendations for improvement

- The formulation of standards for evaluating dissertations and the clarification of them to students are not being implemented as stipulated in Article 14-2, paragraph (2) of the Standards for Establishment of Graduate Schools, and improvements are needed.
