Good practices

- For entrance examination interviews, the university has introduced the use of rubrics evaluation sheets across-the-board, maintaining fairness while selecting students in accordance with each faculty's admission policy. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- At the Itabashi Campus, a lecture recording and distribution system has been implemented whereby all lectures are recorded and made available for viewing on-campus, helping students with reviewing lessons. This initiative is worthy of high evaluation.
- The qualities and abilities that students are guaranteed to acquire are redefined as Acquisition Goals in accordance with the social situation as well as changes/developments in the academic field. Based on these Acquisition Goals, diploma policies are specified and supplemented, and efforts are made to utilize these in nurturing students' qualities and abilities and in evaluations. These initiatives are worthy of high evaluation.
- The Hachioji Campus is fully equipped with facilities for implementing active-learning-style classes, and using these facilities classes are conducted that enable students to acquire the attitude and skills required for working together with others. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
- At the Hachioji and Utsunomiya Campuses, student portfolios including their charts and diploma supplements are prepared and effectively utilized. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- In March 2017, the Itabashi Campus became the first university/hospital administration office to be designated by the Tokyo Metropolitan Government as a Facility Taking Excellent Specific

Global Warming Countermeasures (Near-Top-level), and the university received this accreditation every year through to the 2020 academic year. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.

Recommendations for improvement

- The fill rate of total capacity for the Department of Biosciences, Faculty of Science and Engineering and the Department of Occupational Therapy, Faculty of Fukuoka Medical Technology is less than 70%, and so improvements are required.
