Good practices

- Faculty are able to share information about student absence investigations conducted on a weekly basis through the collaboration of faculty and staff. This enables faculty to provide students with suitable course guidance quickly, thereby reducing the number of students taking a leave of absence or dropping out. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
- The GP (Grade Point) distribution for each subject is made available to faculty and staff, and students through the Active Portal academic affairs system. In addition to ensuring the fairness of grades, this system is also useful in the inspection and evaluation of learning outcomes. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
- Under the President-assessed Special Education/Research Funding Program, the Carbon-neutral Promotion category has been newly added to the existing categories of Priority Education, Priority Research, Extra-curricular Scientific and Technological Activities, Community-centrism, and SDGs, thereby promoting research activities in line with the university's objectives and educational targets. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
