Good practices

- The university elects members of the Student Examination Preparation Committee for assisting students to acquire registered veterinary nurse certification, and a high pass rate is being maintained due to examination preparation measures based on students' independent activities. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
- The university maintains a comprehensive registry of dog breeds that are kept as pets by general households and provides practical training with these dog breeds (Model Dog System). This system is worthy of evaluation as an educational method that utilizes the university's distinctive qualities as well as an activity that contributes to society.

Recommendations for improvement

- With regard to students' mental and physical well-being, improvements are urgently required so that a school physician is appointed in accordance with provisions of the School Health and Safety Act.
