Good practices

- The junior college is making learning outcomes visible based on the results of strengthening initiatives to assure quality upon graduation under the AP (Acceleration Program for University Education Rebuilding). This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- The junior college provides a place for learning that meets the wishes of the community and the needs of high school students, places an emphasis on links with the community, and the junior college overall and all its departments satisfy both their yearly enrollment quotas and total capacity, all of which are worthy of evaluation.
- The Out Campus Study, which is a unique off-campus type of class in which experience-based learning is conducted at local businesses, local government and local organizations has been established. Out Campus Days are held in which students study outside of the junior college together, and many of the students experience these classes that lead to good education effects. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
- The students' learning activities, extra-curricular activities, media exposure and job placement achievements are comprehensively compiled in the Student Annual Report, which is used to ascertain general results including school life, and in the improvement of educational content/methods and learning guidance. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- The university encourages staff to acquire qualifications and enroll in distance learning graduate schools, has developed the Regulations Concerning the Incorporated Educational Institution Matsusho Gakuen's System for the Promotion of Training by Full-Time Staff, and by providing financial assistance it improves the motivation of staff. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
