### Good practices

- A Faculty and Staff Handbook containing the university's management principles, educational principles and mid- and long-term plan is distributed every year and a Faculty and Staff Handbook: Tamateyama Gakuen A-to-Z every other year to faculty and staff. The fact that the university is making efforts for the communication and understanding of management principles, educational principles, mid- and long-term plans and action plans is worthy of high evaluation.
- As a part of its initiatives to directly ascertain the opinions and requests of students, and improve the environment in a joint effort by students and faculty and staff, the Tama Food Working Team has been launched and actually improved the cafeteria. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- As a designated refuge area for Kashiwara City, the university implements the preparation of manuals, resources and equipment as a refuge station, and each year jointly hosts refuge area operation drills with the community and fire stations that are participated in by faculty, staff, students and pupils. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- The evaluations of both the annual Self-inspection and Evaluation Sheet and the single-year Action Plan formulated according to the mid- and long-term plan are written in line with evidence and the university's thoroughness in evidence-based evaluations is worthy for evaluation.
