Good practices

- In order to attempt class improvements and raise quality, the university publishes an FD (Faculty Development) Handbook each academic year, which is a manual compiling successful examples of class improvement initiatives and related literature and data, and distributes it to all faculty including part-time faculty. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- Faculty who participate in external training workshops write reports on them, and by posting them on the incorporated entity's groupware Information Sharing Space, attempts are made to share knowledge and information; the fact that mechanisms are being created to constantly improve the quality and ability of all of the faculty and staff is worthy of evaluation.
- The Fukuhara Gakuen Factbook recording the situation of the incorporated entity and the university is compiled annually and distributed to faculty and staff. Each member of the university's faculty and staff uses this as evidence literature for self-inspection and evaluation activities, in addition to which it is recorded in the business plan action plans and utilized in the creation of progress reports and achievement reports. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.

Recommendations for improvement

- With regard to the Faculty of Economics' Department of Regional Development, measures for improvement have been considered and implemented but the fill rate is still less than 70% of the total capacity. Improvements to secure entrants are required.
