- In order to assure the objectivity and fairness of self-inspection and evaluation activities, an External Evaluation Committee has been established consisting of experts from outside of the university, and the university strives to make improvements and reforms reflecting the opinions of the external evaluators. - The university publishes its KOKUSHIKAN UNIVERSITY IR Data Book, which contains all the basic information about it, and the fact that it eagerly attempts to disclose information internally and externally is worthy of evaluation.
