Good practices

- The SUMS Point System has been introduced, and by evaluating the extra-curricular activities of students, social contribution activities are supported and encouraged. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- The promotion of digitization to encourage effective and efficient learning with the visualization of learning and student management such as checks on the state of learning (student records) through SUMS-PO, and the provision of varied learning contents through the e-learning learningBox is an initiative worthy of evaluation.
- The Medical Personnel Underlying Ability Education experience program is participated in by many administrative staff to provide instruction to students, and the fact that opportunities are provided for administrative staff to improve their own professional skills through teaching is worthy of high evaluation.
- With regards to energy-saving, the lighting and air-conditioning systems have been upgraded to more energy-efficient models, the Expenditure Reduction Promotion Committee pursues a number of initiatives, and the fact that the university has significantly cut the amount of energy it uses between the academic years 2014 and 2020 is worthy of evaluation.
