Good practices

- A tutor system has been established, faculty members place an emphasis on communication with students, and support is provided from entry through to graduation. This initiative is worthy of high evaluation.

Recommendations for improvement

- Though improvement measures are considered and implemented, the fill rate of the total capacity of the Faculty of Nutritional Sciences' Department of Nutritional Sciences is less than 70% and improvements are required in order to secure entrants.
- The number of students in the Faculty of Human Care at Makuhari's Department of Clinical Engineering, a new department that is yet to reach the year in which it will produce its first graduates, is below 50% and improvements are required.
