Good practices

- At the School of Nursing and the School of Nursing at the Matsuyama Campus, an advisor system has been introduced, and using Advisor-Student Records the faculty in charge share information on state of attendance and learning with each student and make efforts to provide student support throughout their four years at the university. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- A class-by-class syllabus had been developed, and through efforts such as describing in detail the class content each time classes are held, better-planned learning effects and class content as well as active learning are encouraged. And these initiatives are worthy of high evaluation.
- Using an LMS (Learning Management System), short tests are implemented after every class on all courses in order to make formative assessments, and using these results as feedback links in with improvements to educational content/methods and learning guidance. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
