- As a job placement measure for students returning to their home cities, the university concludes agreements with local governments in places where large numbers of students originate from, and these students are supported by Job Placement Office advisors who originate from the various local governments concerned. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- Through the Free Vegetable Stand that is provided with the cooperation of local government, people in the community and local businesses, the daily lives and financial support of students is improved, and this initiative is worthy of evaluation.
