Good practices

- As a form of learning and class instruction support, a student-to-student On-campus Individual Instruction System has been introduced, and this is useful in the improvement of study volition and academic attainment. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.

Recommendations for improvement

- On diplomas the awarding of credits is conferred under the President's name but the conferral of degrees is under the name of the Tuszuki Education Group President, who is concurrently the Chair of the Board of Directors of the university's incorporated entity. Improvements are required in order that they are conferred under the President's name.
- The procedures regarding the President's final decision on the admission of students are conducted only verbally, and the fact that they cannot be verified from written minutes requires improvements.
- The fact that the responsibility of the President in decision making and education and learning management of the university is not assured is a problem in terms of the functionality of internal quality assurance, and improvements are required.
