Good practices

- Attempts are made to record and share the first-year students' state of learning and well-being conditions through a learning portfolio, faculty members of the departments conduct weekly interviews with them and provide appropriate advice, all of which are worthy of evaluation.

Recommendations for improvement

- The fulfillment rate of the total capacity of the Faculty of Engineering's Department of Electronic Robot Engineering is under 70% and improvements are required.
- In the Graduate School of Engineering, the evaluation criteria for the dissertation review are not defined and not published on the website, which requires improvement.
- The number of faculty of the university as a whole is short of two professors compared to the number stipulated by the Standards for the Establishment of Universities, so improvements are needed to secure the requisite number of professors as soon as possible.
- There are issues requiring improvement regarding the establishment and publication of evaluation criteria related to dissertations and the securing of the number of professors stipulated by the Standards for the Establishment of Universities. As it cannot be said that the functionality of internal quality assurance is adequate, improvements are required.
