Good practices

- In order to promote activities based on the university's founding principles and its future vision, these are detailed in a pocket credo carried by faculty and staff and shown in various places on campus. The fact that efforts are conducted to endow an awareness of them among faculty and staff as well as students is worthy of evaluation.
- The university's own PR magazines such as the Style K (high school edition) and First Step, also provide information other than about the university such as university entrance exams and qualifications and jobs. Career path selection support is thus provided to high school students aiming to pursue medical occupations. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- The graduate school students who become TAs (teaching assistants) are obliged to undergo prior training and submit performance records. The fact that the university serves as a place for graduate school students to gain educational experience, rather than just a place for learning and class instruction support, is worthy of evaluation.

Recommendations for improvement

- The fill rate of total capacity of the Faculty of Health Sciences' Department of Therapeutic Health Promotion is under 70%, and further improvements towards full capacity are required.
