Good practices

- At the university's Tokyo campus, several staff with the same nationalities of the current students who account for a large number of students are assigned, and they offer student consultation in their own mother tongues. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- The syllabuses for each course contain a column clearly indicating the matters improved based on the results of the class evaluation questionnaires conducted in the previous academic year. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- Questionnaire surveys are conducted for the participants in SD (Staff Development) activities, the satisfaction level and themes hoped for are ascertained, and the university is pursuing organizational initiatives towards the implementation of future SD activities. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.

Recommendations for improvement

- The audit report is not submitted to the Board of Councilors, and the fact that audit reporting is not conducted requires improvements.
- The general evaluation stipulated in the Shiseikan University Self-inspection and Evaluation Regulations has not been implemented, and the report of the university's incorporated institution has not been created. Since the matters in accordance with regulations are not being implemented, improvements are required.
