Good practices

- The university holds a President's Workshop for University Reform, provides opportunities to hear directly from students about the university's future vision, and issues concerning pre-matriculation education and study in the lower student years. The results obtained from the workshop are reflected in the establishment of a Learning Commons, and this initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- In order to implement organizational education, a mechanism has been constructed in which meetings on academic administration are held with part-time faculty, and the educational content of each course, educational methods, and class content and degree of progress are coordinated across the entire university, including the secretariat. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- The university has introduced external assessments, and the S-log system in which students can check the state of their progress in terms of the diploma policy using a radar chart, and the enthusiastic initiatives to visualize students' growth are worthy of evaluation.
- The Institutional Research (IR) Center collects data about activities concerning internal quality assurance in each division, and processes and edits the data to compile the Setsunan University Fact book. The university uses the Fact Book as the main launching point for internal self-inspection and evaluation. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
