Good practices

- The Transportation Expense Support Program for Job Hunting in Remote Areas has been established, and the university is helping to cover the travel expenses of students for their employment tests and internship participation. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- Antibody tests for measles, rubella, chicken pox, and mumps are conducted as a part of the medical examinations at the time of enrollment, explanations about the need for vaccinations are given to students with low antibody titers, and the university covers part of the expenses and recommends vaccinations. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
- The assessment policy is developed to inspect and evaluate learning outcomes based on a variety of evaluation indicators. In addition to working on improvements to educational content/methods and academic guidance, the data related to evaluation indicators is analyzed and organized in an easily viewed manner and used in various fields. These initiatives are worthy of high evaluation.

Recommendations for improvement

- With regard to business reports, they are reported to the Board of Councilors and its opinions are sought before the approval of the Board of Directors. In line with Article 46 of the Private Schools Act and Article 34, paragraph (2) of the articles of endowment, improvements are required so that the opinions of the Board of Councilors are sought after approval by the Board of Directors.
