## **Good practices**

- By setting the overseas study trip program as a required course in the first year of the Faculty of International Liberal Arts, the motivation of students for studying English is heightened through the early experience of interaction with other cultures. This initiative is worthy of high evaluation.
- O A student FD (Faculty Development) Committee Member System has been established with the objective of considering teaching from students' perspectives. Opinions are collected directly from students after observing actual lessons, and are linked in with the promotion of FD activities. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- A University-Wide Meeting involving the entire faculty and staff of the incorporated entity is convened twice a year, and the direction and basic thinking of the Chair of the Board of Directors toward the achievement of the incorporated entity's mission and goals are directly expressed. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.

## **Recommendations for improvement**

O With regard to the admission of students, deliberations are made by an Entrance Examination Appraisal Council whose relationship with the Faculty Council cannot be verified, and it therefore cannot be said that the Faculty Council is deliberating the matter. Accordingly, improvements are required.
