Good practices

- The university's basic concept is "Success for Each and Every Student," and it is implementing unique initiatives such as the Minor System, Long-term Learning System and Early Graduation Educational Programs to realize the individuality and diversity of a wide range of students. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
- Under the Taisei Gakuin University Student Success Collaboration Project (TGU-SSCP), staff volunteers enthusiastically conduct the planning, proposal and management of various events contributing to increasing student satisfaction, and maintaining and improving motivation regarding university life. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.

Recommendations for improvement

- The fill rates of the total capacity of the Department of Modern Business, Faculty of Business Administration, and the Department of Child Development and Department of Health and Sport, Faculty of Human Studies are under 70% and improvements are required.
- An annual upper limit of course credits for registration has not been set in the Department of Child Development. Accordingly, improvements are required.
