### Good practices

- The university's own learning support system, "Manabiba," has been established as a bridge between high school and university education, and is highly evaluated for its support of students' self-learning and self-education.
- It is highly commendable that the library learning commons is available 24 hours a day for the convenience of students' study, while taking the safety management of students during late-night hours into consideration.
- The Chiba Institute of Science Risk and Crisis Management Office, headed by a faculty member of the Faculty of Risk and Crisis Management, has been alerted to unforeseen situations in normal times and, in the event of an emergency, has implemented initial response activities in accordance with the Basic Plan for Emergency Response in collaboration with external organizations. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.

### Recommendations for improvement

- The capacity-filling ratio is less than 0.7 for the Department of Pharmacy in the Faculty of Pharmacy, the Department of Health and Medical Sciences and the Department of Animal Risk Management in the Faculty of Risk and Crisis Management, and the Department of Nursing in the Faculty of Nursing, which requires improvement.
- Improvement is needed with regard to the university's continuously negative current account balance.
