Good practices

- A Class Counselor System managed by teachers in charge of seminar classes is being used as a mechanism to assess each student's academic progress and provide the necessary support. Each seminar supervisor carefully advises between 20 to 40 students, from students on their first year all the way until their graduation. This initiative is worthy of evaluation.
- With regards to Ukrainian refugee students, an international human relief initiative was swiftly prepared by the university after the breakout of the conflict with Russia, providing a learning environment and financial support for the students. These initiatives are worthy of a high evaluation.

Recommendations for improvement

- Specially Appointed Professors are being treated as full-time faculty, but there is a stipulation in the “Regulations Regarding Specially Appointed Professors and Specially Appointed Associate Professors” that they are treated as part-time faculty. There is a need to promptly review and recommend improvements to these regulations.
