## **Good practices**

- The college offers career support adapted to the diverse needs of students through its Job Placement Office in the Career Center. This includes assigning external staff with certified career counsellor qualifications and installing remote interview booths in the Center. These services, along with career education within the curriculum, have contributed to high job placement rates among the students. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
- The college has assigned a physician, gynecologist, orthopedist, and nurse to the Health Management Center. The orthopedist leads the treatment of sports-related injuries and develops rehabilitation plans tailored to the specific characteristics of each sport. All staff members, collaborating with sports coaches, provide comprehensive support until students make a full recovery and can return to their sports activities. This system is highly commendable.
- In addition to the fixed-amount research funds, the college provides competitive research funds such as the Joint Research Fund, Nikaido Research Grant, and Challenge Research Fund. These programs actively promote research and have contributed to an increasing number of projects being adopted for the Grants-in-Aid for Scientific Research. These initiatives are worthy of evaluation.
