Good practices

- The internship systems, comprising the Long-term Corporate Internship and School Internship are integrated into the educational curriculum as career-related courses. The practice of students self-evaluating their experiences using the Fundamental Competencies for Working Persons Evaluation Sheet and during post-program debriefing sessions contributes to raising students' career awareness. These initiatives are worthy of high evaluation.
- The university's DiCoRes Program, which equips students with professional skills, and the Long-term Field Study Program, which offers opportunities to genuinely address local community issues through active learning methods, are both initiatives that integrate education, research, and social contribution. These initiatives are worthy of high evaluation.

Recommendations for improvement

- The fill rate of the total capacity of the Department of Childhood Communication Studies, Faculty of Modern Communication Studies is under 70% and improvements are required.
